 - Some students will need to check in throughout the day.

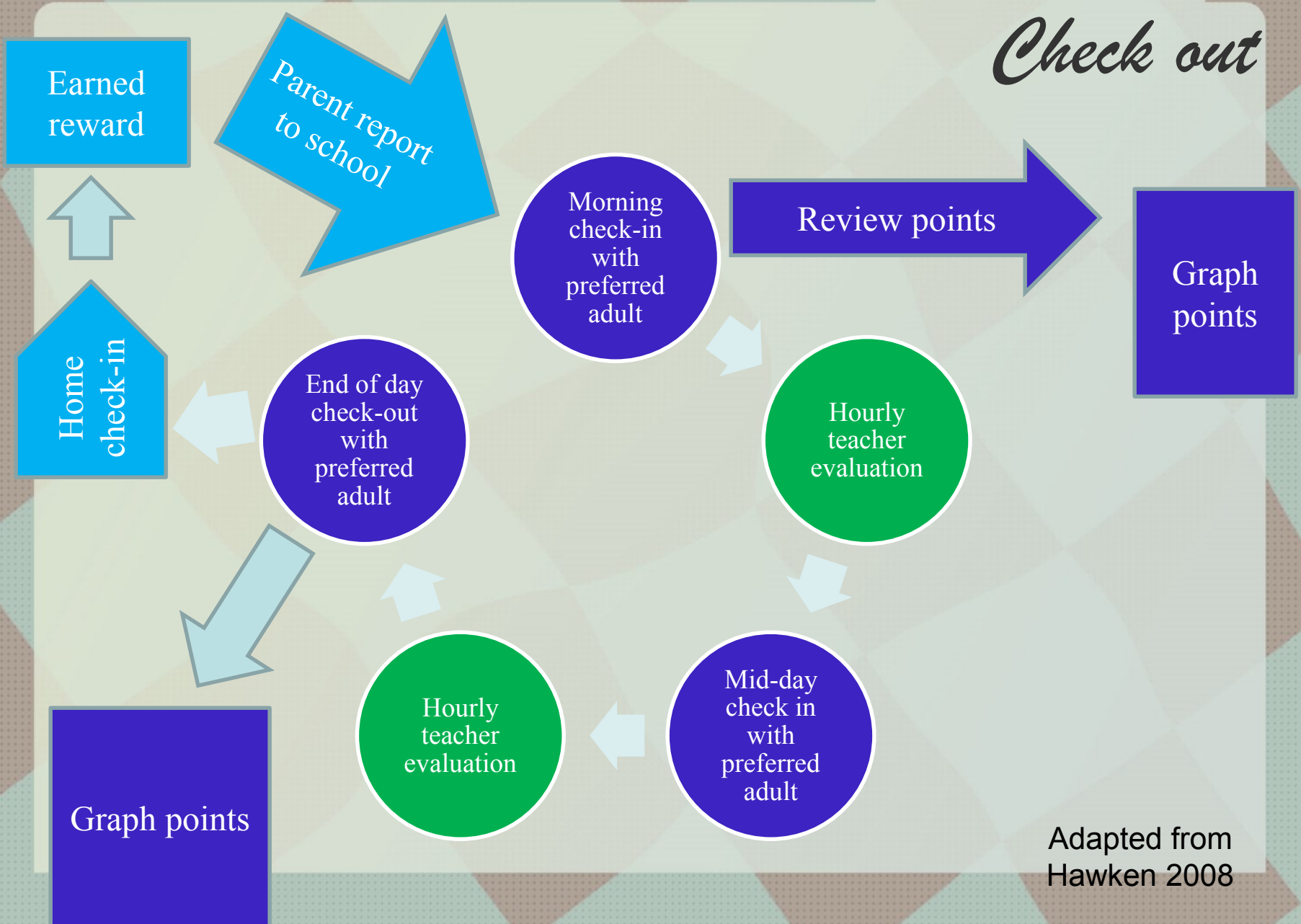
